CONCEPTUAL SUBSTANCE JERSZY SEYMOUR BLESS EL ULTIMO GRITO JÖRG HUNDERTPFUND RONEN KADUSHIN OSKO+DEICHMANN JUDITH SENG DAVID KRINGS TINA ROEDER

THE EXHIBITION CONCEPTUAL SUBSTANCE SHOWCASES CONCEPT-BASED FURNITURE DESIGN THAT CONTRIBUTES TOWARDS A CONTEMPORARY COMPREHENSION OF DESIGN AND ITS MANIFOLD EXPRESSIONS.

ON SHOW ARE 9 INTERNATIONAL DESIGNERS, ALL BASED IN BERLIN – DOUBTERS, QUESTIONERS, STORYTELLERS AND REBELS, WHO ARE SEARCHING FOR WHAT DESIGN CAN BE, FEARLESS TO STRIKE A NEW PATH. WHAT THEY LOOK FOR IS SUBSTANTIAL SOIL, RADICAL EXPRESSION IN IDEA AND OBJECT.

DESIGN IN THE GALLERY IS MORE THAN EXTRAVAGANT COLLECTOR'S OBJECTS. YOU SEE EXPERIMENTS AND THOUGHTS THAT INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTION DOESN'T USUALLY ALLOW FOR. THE GALLERY PROVIDES A SPACE TO INVESTIGATE MATERIALS, IDEAS, METHODS AND TRADITIONS, EXPLORING DISTINCTIONS BETWEEN AFFLUENCE AND DEPRIVATION — THE ORIGIN AND HERITAGE OF THINGS. BY TRANSFORMING POOR AND ROUGH MATERIALS SUCH AS CARDBOARD, TAPE OR EXPANDING FOAM INTO EXCITING PIECES OF FURNITURE. BY SEEKING ENDLESS VARIATIONS OF AN ARCHETYPAL CHAIR MODEL. BY SHARING BLUEPRINTS OF PRODUCTS ON THE WEB FOR INDIVIDUAL PRODUCTION. EACH DESIGNER IN THEIR OWN WAY HAVE REACTED TO MOVEMENTS AND CHANGES IN A GLOBAL SOCIETY.

THE EXHIBITION IS NOT THE FIRST AND NOT THE LAST TO SHOW CONCEPTUAL DESIGN. YET AS LONG AS WE DO NOT HAVE PROGRESSIVE ADMINISTRATIONS AND NOT ENOUGH AUDACITY WITHIN INDUSTRIES – WE WON'T MISS A CHANCE TO COMMUNICATE THIS SUBSTANCE.

08 **OSKO+DEICHMANN** CLIP CHAIR 2006 · WHILST STROLLING AROUND A BULGARIAN MARKET, A SMALL FOLDABLE BASKET CAUGHT OUR ATTENTION. SINGLE SLATS WERE BEADED ON ROPES TO FORM HINGED SURFACES, WHICH COULD BE TRANSFORMED INTO A CURVED 3-DIMENSIONAL OBJECT. 09 & 11 **JÖRG HUNDERTPFUND** FLEXIONEN 1995-2003 & TRANSITIVE 2005 · FLEXIONEN, 360 VARIATIONS
OF A CHAIR. AN EXPERIMENTAL DECONSTRUCTION OF A SEEMINGLY RIGID TYPOLOGY — THE CHAIR — BASED ON THE
STANDARD STOOL MEASURE OF 45CM X 45CM X 45CM. TRANSITIVE (SHELF) IS PART OF A SERIES OF FURNITURE.
IT IS A FUNCTIONAL SHELF YET AT THE SAME TIME IT DOESN'T WANT TO BE PIGEONHOLED AS A SHELF. IT DEFENDS
ITSELF AGAINST A CATEGORIZATION AND SUGGESTS AN ALTERNATIVE, MORE DISSOLVED POSSIBILITY OF A SHELF.
